



Land cover (detailed map, 2004)

This map is the classification of land cover created by the USDA Forest Service Region 5 State and Private Forestry, Forest Health Protection, and published in June, 2005. The geospatial data are based on IKONOS satellite imagery from 2002 until 2004. The purpose of the map is to provide detailed vegetation information for Guam and to develop a standard vegetation mapping method for Pacific islands.
